Electors will consider the following issue at the election:

- Two (2) Trustees to be elected for a Three (3) year term
- One (1) Trustee to be elected for a Two (2) year term


A qualified registered elector who will be absent from the district during the time the election is being conducted may: a) vote in person in the election administrator's office as soon as the ballots are available and until noon the day before the ballots are scheduled to be mailed; b) make a written request, signed by the applicant and addressed to the election administrator, that the ballot be mailed to an address other than the address that appears on the registration card. The election administrator's office is located at:

**Mineral County Courthouse-300 River St., P.O. Box 550, Superior, MT 59872**

If you miss this regular registration deadline (30 days prior to the election), you may still register for the election by showing up at the county election office up to and including on election day. Between noon and the close of business on the day before Election Day, you may complete and submit a voter registration card, but you will need to return to the district voting location on Election Day to pick up and vote a ballot. The county election office is located at:
